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General and Appointments (written by Ece Tasci and Natalie Wei Ying Chong)

The AV met on Monday, 27.10, for its monthly general assembly. Lal Sonel resigned from her position as President but will remain on the team as Project Leader for “How to RWTH,” a project that helps new international students find their way around RWTH. Natalie Chong was elected President following Lal Sonel's resignation, and Ece Tasci was elected Vice President.

After Ece Tasci stepped down from her role as Project Leader for Social Media due to her election as Vice President, Oguzhan Yilmaz was elected as the new Project Leader for Social Media.

Daniel Kusuma has stepped down as Project Leader for Consultations. Denizsu Topkaya and Daria Kortlepel were then elected Project Leaders for Consultations. They will be responsible for In-Person Consultations, responding to emails, and organizing seminars.

Furthermore, on the 14.11, Natalie Chong and Ece Tasci joined the recent JourFixe with the rector of the RWTH together with other members of the AStA.

16.10.2025 Paint the Night Away

AV's “Paint the Night Away” made its return on 16.10, beginning at 18:00 and ending at around 22:00. Around 70 participants painted a ghost set in a wheat field. The relaxed atmosphere and step-by-step guidance helped make it another peaceful and creative evening. Given the strong turnout and positive feedback, AV plans to host this event again later in the semester.

30.10.2025 Escape Room

On the 30.10, after weeks of preparation the AV launched a new event: “Escape Room” Halloween-themed. There were around 60 participants who participated in 8 rounds between both escape rooms, as the event ran from 18:00 to 22:00. AV used both the ground-floor and second-floor rooms to run two different scenarios, where teams of 6-8 participants try to find a way out in 30 minutes. The ground-floor room featured an airport waiting room theme, while the second floor depicted a “falling plane” scenario. Due to the event's success, AV plans to bring it back in future semesters.

06.11.2025 Game Night

On 06.11, AV organized “Game Night”, welcoming around 40 participants for an evening of classic and modern board games, which ran from 18:00 to 21:30. The event encouraged students to mingle and unwind after a long day. This casual format remains a student favorite and will make its return later in the semester.

The consultations team helps international students with their immigration law problems by e-mail on a daily basis. The in-person consultation sessions are offered twice a week every Wednesday in Humboldt Haus and Thursdays at AStA Office. In the following are the in-person consultation sessions from 18.10, 2025, until 14.11.

The Consultations Team hosted a joint seminar with the BSHK on 10.11. in Humboldt-Haus, the Seminar explained and discussed the rights and duties of the SHK / WHK (student assistants and research assistants respectively). The team is still planning a seminar with the Career Center on 25.11. Further Seminars and plans are being planned.

The Consultations Team has been continuing the lawyer appointments on Zoom. Since the last report, there were the following lawyer-appointments-sessions: 29.10.2025, 12.11.2025.

Furthermore, the consultations team has been confronted with two major cases recently. In order to try and resolve these cases, Lal Sonel has attended 9 meetings with the International Office, the immigration office, and the affected person. For any questions, Lal Sonel remains the contact person for both cases.

The AV continues to use its social media channels to promote its events, inform students, and provide useful tips for international students through posts.
