The AV had a bonding night on November 28th.

20.11.2025 Karaoke Night

On November 20th, the AV organized the second Karaoke Night of the semester. The event began at 18:00 and ended around 23:00. As usual, participants were able to request songs and sing their favorite tunes throughout the evening. The event was attended by approximately 50 people throughout the evening. The AV will organize a third Karaoke Night in December.

Pub Quiz 27.11.2025

AV's Pub Quiz made its return on November 27th, beginning at 18:00 and ending around 21:30. Around 50 students participated, competing across four diverse categories: "Math and Logic", "Retro", "Famous Duos" and "Mysteries and Unsolved Phenomena". The quiz fostered a lively atmosphere, and the winning team members each received Christmas-themed mugs. Due to the high energy and success of the evening, AV will continue hosting pub quizzes throughout the semester.

Run 'n Dine 29.11.2025

AV scheduled Run 'n Dine for 29 November; however, the event was canceled due to low registration. Participation in Run 'n Dine has declined significantly, so AV will discontinue the event in future semesters.

Karaoke Night 04.12.2025

December 4th was chosen by AV for the third Karaoke Night of the semester. The event started at 18:00 and finished at around 22:00 with around 40 attendees. Participants were encouraged to request songs via the karaoke software "KaraFun." AV's final Karaoke Night of the semester is scheduled for January.

The AV continues to use its social media channels to promote its events, inform students, and provide useful tips for international students through posts. In addition to posts, the AV also makes reposts whenever relevant information is posted on official accounts such as the RWTH, International Office, and Stadt Aachen.

In the last months, the AV informed students on its social platforms about the different events organized and gave general information. The AV published a post about its events 'Run N' Dine' (21.11), 'Pub Quiz' (23.11), 'Karaoke Night' (28.11), 'Game Show Night' (05.12) and 'Paint the Night Away' (12.12). To promote the event 'Run N' Dine', the AV also posted a reel showing various foods (19.11). In preparation for the event 'Game Show Night', the AV asked for short answers to student life-related questions in the style of Family Feud through stories (01-10.12).

The AV also informed students about the continuation of the in-person consultations for December (01.12). In collaboration with Psychological Counseling, the AV met with a representative (18.11) to discuss final touches on the next episode of the mental health YouTube series 'I Am Okay', which has the theme 'Anxiety'. The AV also conducted interviews (11.12) and gained 2 members.
